Main responsibilities and expectations

- As a specialist, you will participate in all parts of the work at the clinic such as on-call, departmental work and outpatient care.
- You will manage acutely ill patients with a wide range of internal medicine conditions.
- At the outpatient ward, there is the possibility to focus more on certain patient groups.
- You should enjoy training and supervising junior doctors and participating in improvement work.

What's expected of you

- To have medical and specialist titles issued or recognized by the European Union.
- To show interest in teamwork and be willing to contribute to the clinic's development.
- To be able to complete the intensive Swedish language course, which is part of the MediCarrera program.

Salary and Conditions

- Salary for a new specialist with no experience: 70.000 sek / month (6040 euros) gross.
- The salary is set individually according to specialist's years of experience.

- A free intensive language course for partners and children of school age. Kindergarten for the youngest.

ABOUT THE CLINIC



Swedish healthcare, including that in Värmland, is known for its high quality and adherence to strict regulations and quality standards. The healthcare system is designed to provide equal access to healthcare services for all residents. Like the rest of Sweden, Värmland has a publicly funded healthcare system. This means that healthcare services are funded by taxes and are generally accessible to all residents, regardless of their income or insurance status.

Torsby is one of three towns in Värmland with a general hospital in the town centre. The hospital is open around-the-clock and offers both emergency care and specialised treatments. The emergency and outpatient clinic for all specialities is housed in fresh premises. The hospital is flow-oriented and based on the patient's needs. They work based on the vision "to create a hospital where we can imagine ourselves being patients".

Activities are carried out in medicine, surgery, orthopaedics, urology, gynaecology, anaesthesia, surgery and intensive care, radiology, laboratory, physiotherapy, occupational therapy and palliative care. The operations include both orthopaedics and surgery, including endoscopic operations. There is also a dialysis unit.

REGION VÄRMLAND

Sweden



Värmland, located in west-central Sweden, offers a beautiful natural landscape with forests, lakes, and rolling countryside for outdoor enthusiasts.

The region is between Stockholm and Oslo, offering a peaceful and scenic environment while still being accessible to city life. Värmland has a rich cultural heritage, with traditional festivals such as the "Värmland Rune Singer Festival" taking place throughout the year, allowing residents to learn about and experience traditional Swedish culture.


Region Värmland manages three hospitals in Karlstad, Arvika, and Torsby and provides a variety of specialist clinics. The organization has a robust healthcare workforce comprising approximately 700 doctors, 2,200 nurses, and 1,200 nursing assistants. The organization is seeking medical specialists across various specialities and is a major employer in Värmland, with a workforce of over 7,400 employees. It operates 20 health centres that offer primary care and maternal and child health services.

Region Värmland has extensive experience in recruiting medical professionals from overseas and is well-versed in the laws and regulations related to the migration and authorization of foreign doctors. This experience and knowledge make it an attractive destination for medical specialists looking to work in the European Union.
